Volunteer at Siouxland Libraries! We need you! We depend upon volunteers to maintain present services and to expand into new areas.

Our three main requirements from volunteers are time, talent, and dedication. Other skills that are helpful include:

- Ability to handle a variety of materials in various forms and media.
- Ability to identify, manipulate, sort, or shelve.
- Ability to use computers.

Some positions require the ability to stand or sit for long periods of time, or to push a loaded book cart.

Volunteer Opportunities and Work Schedule

A qualified applicant is assigned to a specific branch or division. (Divisions include Children's, Circulation, Information, and Outreach Services.) Volunteers work hours that fit into their schedules and when supervision by staff is available.

Minimum Age to Volunteer

Children may volunteer at Siouxland Libraries if they have completed the seventh grade. Parental consent must be obtained for applicants under 18 years of age.

Areas of Interest

There is a wide selection of work duties available at all of our library locations. You may choose from shelving library materials or other light duties. Our Day Care Delivery Service requires delivery of books and materials to local day cares. Deliveries would only require about an hour of your time each week.

Benefits

One of the main benefits of volunteering at Siouxland Libraries is the satisfaction of making a contribution to the Sioux Falls community.
