

RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A SIOUX FALLS SCHOOL TRAFFIC SAFETY ADVISORY COMMITTEE.

WHEREAS, it has been recommended by a citizen's group, meeting informally to discuss school traffic safety, that a committee be established to advise the City Commission of the City of Sioux Falls concerning various matters regarding school traffic safety; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission deems such recommendation advisable;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF SIOUX FALLS, SOUTH DAKOTA, that:

1. There be established a "Sioux Falls School Traffic Safety Advisory Committee" for the City of Sioux Falls composed of fifteen (15) members appointed by the City Commissioner in charge of the Traffic Engineering Department and confirmed by the City Commission.


2. The term of each member shall be two years or until his successor is appointed and qualified; except that elected and appointed governmental officials may serve indefinite terms. Section 2-5 of the City Ordinances shall govern.

3. The Committee will meet at least quarterly at a time and place selected by the Committee and at such other times as determined by said Committee.


4. The Committee shall select a chairperson, vice-chairperson, secretary, and such other officers as they deem necessary from their membership.

5. The Committee may make recommendations and give advice to the Sioux Falls City Commission and/or the Sioux Falls Board of Education in regard to matters relating to school traffic safety.
