**Disclaimer:** The ADA Accessibility Review Board is a board of community members volunteering their time to give necessary feedback on projects of the City which may have an impact on Title II of The American's with Disabilities Act. The intent of the review is not to evaluate complete compliance with an accessibility standard, but to ensure overall programmatic accessibility. The Board is not presented all the information and is not given sufficient time for a thorough review. The Board's review is merely cursory and should only be considered a recommendation of the Board. The Board recommendation should not be considered a certification that the project meets ADA standards. The Board only reviews the project based on The American's with Disabilities Act Accessibility Guidelines and other U.S. Access Board guidance and does not address any local codes, such as any building codes or fire and safety codes. Any conflicts in local codes should be addressed by the appropriate parties.

**Barrier Removal – ADA Curb Ramp Upgrades:** Wes Phillips and Shane Balk

Phillips and Balk presented a color-coded diagram/map of the ADA Curb Ramp Upgrades (Barrier Removal) in various locations throughout the city. It showed Phases 1 through 5 of the ADA Ramp Project, as well as ramps that were repaired with past, current, and future street projects. The primary focus of these projects is to remove barriers. Phillips and Balk also indicated that the City addresses ramp/sidewalk concerns when they are presented.

ADA Accessibility Review board members indicated an appreciation for the information provided, but a recommendation for approval was not needed at this time.
