CALL TO ORDER

A quorum being present, the meeting was called to order by Haggar at 1:34 a.m.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

A motion was made by Osterloo and seconded by Hartmann to approve the minutes from the meeting on April 30, 2019, Vote to approve: 4 Yeses. Motion passed.

BOARD MEMBER ELECTIONS

Osterloo was nominated for Chair and unanimously elected.
Monson was nominated for Vice Chair and unanimously elected.

BUSINESS OR PENDING ISSUES BROUGHT BEFORE THE BOARD

Update on sidewalk complaint near Western Avenue and I-229 was moved to next meeting.

City Engineers Weston Philips and Mike Heiberger reported they would be taking over the work on sidewalk issues. The City is in the third year of sidewalk and accessible ramp transition plan projects in response to an ADA complaint. The City spent \$920,000 on improvements in 2018. They will provide updates to ADA Accessibility Review Board and Federal Highway Administration about progress. There are 1,200 miles of sidewalk in Sioux Falls; this grows about 2% each year. They are inspecting existing and new sidewalks.

Hartmann remarked that on 41st and West Avenue on the south side of 41st there are no sidewalks by some businesses, and people have to walk on grass to get to Costco. Philips explained this is a requirement that has been added to international building code and the City is enforcing it on new sites or renovated sites. The City doesn't make property owners add it if they do not have an active project.
