

**SIOUX FALLS BOARD OF HEALTH  
MINUTES

Minutes of the April 19<sup>th</sup> meeting were reviewed. Mike motioned for approval of the minutes. Gwen seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

**Health Department Vision and Strategic Plan**

Jill gave an overview of the Health Department Strategic Plan. The mission of the Health Department is to improve the quality of life for residents of Sioux Falls by preventing or controlling disease, mitigating adverse health conditions and threats, and by providing an open door to primary health services. The Health department will meet the vision and mission through 5 key strategies. These strategies are monitoring community trends, promoting health, maintaining quality, assuring fiscal strength and creating an enthusiastic workforce. Dan motioned to approve and support the plan. Mike seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

**Animal Control Update**

Kyle Hoekstra introduced Mike Colwell. Mike is the new PD supervisor for the Animal Control Division. Animal Control hired a temporary employee in May to help handle the increased summer call volume. The call volume showed an 18% increase in May. Animal Control handles approximately 1400 calls a month.

Staff has been reviewing the dangerous animal ordinance. This is in the early stage of review but changes to the ordinance may be coming.

Alicia gave a state rabies breakdown report for 2011. There was a 25% increase in animals that tested positive for rabies in 2011. Out of 711 animals tested 40 were positive. There were no human rabies cases in 2011.

**Daycare Ordinance Specifications**

Jill presented the highlighted changes to the daycare ordinance that have occurred in the last year. One significant change was the fee structure. A requirement of insurance coverage was added. Also the ordinance details what is required of a daycare that has been revoked.
