- Sonia Sotomayer Crosswalk There is a crosswalk is on the east side of the building
 that has a curb, not a ramp, and is midblock in the middle of the drop off lane. There
 are ramps at each corner, which the City is planning to replace this summer. We plan
 to remove the crosswalk that is midblock signs and markings. All agreed it would be
 safer to cross at the corners rather than midblock in the drop off lane.
- Dezignline equipment by Hawthorne In conjunction with the North Minnesota Avenue project, the City will put in a temporary bike and pedestrian lane separated by delineators on Second or Third Street over by Hawthorne.
