The bylaws were changed in 1983 by the City Commission, with many changes since then. Over the last few years, we have found it difficult to find members.

Sam Treblicock from the Bicycle Committee came to talk to PATH to potentially establish an Active Transportation Board as the official board for walking, biking, and safe school routes; bringing all the committees together. PATH would still remain together and would become a subcommittee of the Action Transportation Board. That would allow us to become an informal committee instead of a formal committee and would not have to have a quorum every time giving us flexibility and would be citizen led.
